Inspired by the symbolic pattern present in Balinese architecture, our resident model maker, Made Idiawan has designed and created the Patra Punggal collection.

The Patra Punggal motif is prevalent in most temples, doorways and arches. Consisting of four basic shapes present in Balinese flora and fauna (The mango seed, a rooster's comb, the jackfruit flower petal and a fern tree), this intricate organic composition signifies the Balinese cultures appreciation and relationship with the natural environment and life. The motif reflects a cyclical pattern of everyday life, something in which made feels correlates with the act of enjoying and sharing a meal.

The collection consists of a versatile range suitable for western and eastern dining styles. With three different glaze finishes (hade green gloss, marigold, ivory white) that enhances the intricate pattern and highlights food presentation, this new collection is homage to the endless beauty and inspiration our environment and culture provides.
